- Develop and implement the Quality led APQP activities specified within company process to assure quality from concept to production.
- Work with purchasing staff to establish quality requirements for external suppliers
- Write technical and management system reports
- Manage and maintain the Company's quality inspection and product release programs for incoming and in-process materials and components, processes and finished goods
- Assess the product specifications of the company and its suppliers and compare with customer requirements
- Maintain and improve product quality by completing product, company, system, compliance and surveillance audits; investigating customer complaints; collaborating with other members of management to develop new product and engineering designs and manufacturing and training methods.
- Implement measures to improve inspection methods, equipment/tool performance, product quality, efficiency and morale.
- Manage and maintain both internal and external Product & Process Non-Conformance Reports (PNCR's)
- Generate requisitions for materials, supplies, equipment parts or repair services based on planned needs.

Skills & Experience Required:

- Degree or HND standard, ideally in a Manufacturing or Engineering discipline
- Minimum of 5 years' experience in manufacturing
- A track record of Continuous Improvement achievements.
- Ideally with Six Sigma or Lean Manufacturing experience.
